Sarawak GOF seizes 342,000 litres of diesel in statewide ops

KUCHING: The Sarawak General Operations Force (GOF) seized more than 342,000 litres of subsidised diesel worth about RM1.8 million under Op Tiris in locations across Sarawak from March 16 to Tuesday.

Sarawak GOF Brigade commander SAC Lim Bak Phai said the operation involved 820 inspections in Kuching, Samarahan, Sri Aman, Sibul,

Kapit, Bintulu, Miri, Lawas, Bau, Serian and Lundu.

He said 58 cases and 69 arrests were recorded, with seizures exceeding RM20.3 million.

"The success proves the continued commitment of the Sarawak GOF Brigade in combating leakage and misappropriation of controlled goods, especially subsidised diesel in the state," he said in a statement.

Lim said the operations involved the brigade's Intelligence Branch as well as the 10th Battalion in Sibul, 11th Battalion in Kuching, 12th Battalion in Miri, and 23rd Battalion in Sri Aman through Op Taring Bravo and Op Taring Batas/Awas.

Apart from diesel, assets and equipment including tanker lorries, heavy machinery and

skid tanks worth nearly RM17.5 million were also confiscated.

More than five tonnes of subsidised cooking oil valued at almost RM40,000 and over seven tonnes of coarse sugar worth more than RM31,000 were also seized, with the overall value including vehicles estimated at nearly RM950,000.

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'Aggressive, continuous operations to continue'

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Lim said the operation also uncovered various syndicate modus operandi involving the storage, transfer and distribution of diesel without permits, believed to be linked to a network involved in the misappropriation of controlled goods in the state.

Among the major successes was the seizure of a tugboat in Bintulu used to store 20,000 litres of diesel without a valid permit, in addition to several other cases involving tanker lorries, heavy machinery and skid tanks in large quantities.

He added that Op Taring Batas/

Awas also succeeded in detecting and foiling attempts to smuggle coarse sugar and subsidised cooking oil at border areas.

"All arrests and seizures have been handed over to the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living for further action and investigation under Section 21 of the Control of Supplies Act 1961," he said.

Lim said the Sarawak GOF Brigade will continue to intensify aggressive and continuous enforcement operations to curb smuggling and leakage of controlled goods to safeguard national security and public interest.

PGA Sarawak perhebat operasi Ops Tiris

820 pemeriksaan dilaksana di seluruh Sarawak dalam tempoh 16 Mac hingga 26 Mei

KUCHING: Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) Briged Sarawak melaksanakan sebanyak 820 pemeriksaan menerusi Ops Tiris di beberapa lokasi seluruh Sarawak sepanjang tempoh 16 Mac hingga 26 Mei lalu.

Operasi melibatkan kawasan Kuching, Samarahan, Sri Aman, Sibul, Kapit, Bintulu, Miri, Lawas, Bau, Serian dan Lundu itu berjaya merekodkan 58 kes dengan 69 tangkapan serta jumlah rampasan bernilai lebih RM20.3 juta.

Komander Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) Briged Sarawak SAC Lim Bak Phai berkata, operasi berkenaan dilaksanakan oleh Cawangan Risik IP PGA Briged Sarawak bersama Batalion 10 Sibul, Batalion 11 Kuching, Batalion 12 Miri dan Batalion 23 Sri Aman menerusi Ops Taring Batas/Awas serta Ops Taring Batas/Awas.

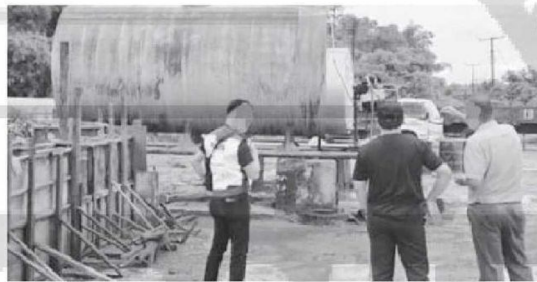
Menurutnya, operasi tersebut berjaya merampas lebih

342,000 liter diesel bersubsidi bernilai kira-kira RM1.8 juta, selain pelbagai aset dan peralatan termasuk lori tangki, jentera berat dan tangki skid yang dianggarkan bernilai hampir RM17.5 juta.

"Turut dirampas lebih lima tan minyak masak bersubsidi bernilai hampir RM40,000 serta lebih tujuh tan gula kasar bernilai lebih RM31,000 dengan keseluruhan nilai rampasan termasuk kenderaan hampir RM950,000.

"Operasi yang dijalankan secara berterusan itu turut mengesan pelbagai modus operandi sindiket termasuk kegiatan penyimpanan, pemindahan dan pengedaran diesel tanpa permit yang dipercayai melibatkan rangkaian penyelewengan barang kawalan di negeri ini," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

Beliau berkata, antara kejayaan utama operasi termasuk rampasan sebuah bot tunda di Bintulu yang digunakan untuk menyimpan 20,000 liter diesel tanpa permit sah, selain

beberapa kes lain membabitkan rampasan lori tangki, jentera berat dan tangki skid dalam kuantiti besar.

"Operasi turut berjaya mengesan dan menumpaskan cubaan penyeludupan gula kasar serta minyak masak bersubsidi di kawasan sempadan menerusi Ops Taring Batas/Awas yang dilaksanakan secara berterusan," tambahnya.

Tambahnya, semua tangkapan dan rampasan telah diserahkan kepada Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN)

Sarawak untuk tindakan serta siasatan lanjut mengikut Seksyen 21 Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961.

Beliau menegaskan PGA Briged Sarawak akan terus mempergiat operasi pen-kuatkuasaan secara agresif dan berterusan tanpa kompromi bagi membanteras aktiviti penyeludupan serta ketirisan barang kawalan demi
