KPDN, GPS to enhance cooperation to expand Food Bank Siswa - Armizan

PUTRAJAYA: The Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry (KPDN) will continue to strengthen its collaboration with the Student Consumer Movement (GPS), to further drive the implementation of the Food Bank Siswa programme across higher learning institutions nationwide.

Minister Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali said GPS, as the representative of student voices, will play a more active role in expanding the programme, particularly in institutions of higher learning (IPT) which have yet to implement it.

He said that, to date, a total of 195 GPS units have been established across public and private institutions of higher learning, university colleges, community colleges and Institutes of Teacher Education (IPGs).

"At the same time, KPDN will also strengthen the role of GPS as one of the key stakeholders in supporting the ministry's functions, particularly in addressing

cost-of-living challenges.

"In addition to their consumer advocacy role, GPS will take on a more active role in mobilising the Student Food Bank programme," he said, in a statement, yesterday.

According to Armizan, KPDN, through the Food Bank Malaysia Secretariat, has been implementing the Food Bank Siswa initiative since 2019, to help stu-

dents access essential food supplies.

He said one of the programme's key objectives is to incorporate food rescue and redistribute surplus food to students in need.

Currently, 32 higher learning institutions, nationwide, are participating in the programme, including public and private universities, IPGs and polytechnics.

He said that, as of Oct 31, the Food Bank Siswa initiative has received contributions from 148 entities, including food manufacturers, retailers, hotel chains and non-governmental organisations, benefiting 51,200 students in need.

Armizan added that the resolutions presented during the Food Bank Malaysia Convention 2025, on Dec 8 and 9, will serve as key inputs for KPDN in formulating the National Food Bank Action Plan 2026–2030.

"Apart from supporting the Sustainable Development Goals, this action plan represents a transformation of the Malaysian Food Bank programme, and forms part of the strategies underpinning the Fourth Pillar of the 13th Malaysia Plan, namely Improving People's Well-being and Environmental Sustainability," he said. – Bernama

KPDN ready to open up new PBP control posts to ensure goods reach remote areas

KUALA LUMPUR: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) is prepared to add new control posts to ensure the supply of essential and subsidised goods reaches remote areas that still face accessibility issues.

Its deputy minister, Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh said that under the Essential Goods Distribution Programme (PBP), the opening of new control posts could be considered if an area is more than 15 kilometres (km) from the existing post and the price of controlled goods sold exceeds 50 per cent of the controlled price due to high logistics costs.

"This is the basic... after 15 km, another checkpoint can be established. If the price of goods in areas without a post increases by more than 50 per cent of the controlled price, it is eligible to be recommended for the establishment of a new goods

distribution post.

"KPDN is open to discussing with Members of Parliament and local representatives to examine areas that require additional PBP control posts," she said when winding up the debate on the Supply Bill 2026 (Budget 2026) for the ministry in the Dewan Negara on Thursday.

She answered questions from Senators Michael Mujah Lihan and Norhasmimi Abdul Ghani, who had previously raised the issue of PBP in remote areas that are difficult to access, leading to soaring logistics costs.

Fuziah said the government has allocated RM250 million to PBP, covering 120 distribution zones, 559 areas, and 820 points of sale nationwide, including remote areas in Sabah, Sarawak and Pahang.

She said that high logistics costs, including boat transport to

the interior areas of Sabah and Sarawak, would cause the prices of controlled goods such as LPG, wheat flour, sugar, and packet cooking oil to skyrocket without government intervention through the PBP.

Addressing the concerns of some senators regarding the difficulty people are having obtaining packet cooking oil for wedding feasts or bulk use by small traders, Fuziah said the daily production contract for subsidised cooking oil has been set at 60,000 cartons per day and cannot be arbitrarily increased.

However, she said KPDN is prepared to consider the views put forward to ensure the needs of the people can be considered without compromising the integrity of the subsidy system.

Meanwhile, Deputy Housing and Local Government Minister Datuk Aiman Athirah Sabu, in

her winding-up remarks, stated that the ministry, through PLANMalaysia, will expand the development of the Malaysia Urban Observatory (MUO) analytical dashboard for flood disaster risk area detection to other states, starting next year.

She said that so far, the development of the analytical dashboard has been completed for Perak and Selangor.

"This dashboard analytics allows for the detection of areas potentially prone to floods and flash floods by identifying land use types such as construction areas, residential and commercial areas as a preventive and mitigation measure in collaboration with local authorities, state governments and the federal government," she said.

Aiman Athirah said the MUO system is integrated with

agencies such as the Department of Irrigation and Drainage (DID) to enhance information accuracy, with real-time data combined using machine learning methods to generate predictions based on patterns such as season, time, location and land use type.

Meanwhile, Deputy Digital Minister Datuk Wilson Ugak Kumbong said the government is developing the National Digital Trust and Data Security Strategy as the main framework to strengthen the governance and data security of the government and the public sector.

He said the strategy unifies the principles of digital security, accountability and trust, in addition to being an important component in Malaysia's efforts to build a safe and resilient AI ecosystem.

Malaysia ketat syarat dedah 'pemilik sebenar' syarikat

Era kerahsiaan yang membolehkan pemilik sebenar syarikat berselindung di sebalik nama proksi atau 'shell company' semakin berakhir di Malaysia.

Laporan penilaian antarabangsa memuji usaha negara yang memperketat syarat pendedahan maklumat Pemilik Benefisial (Beneficial Ownership) bagi mengelak penyalahgunaan entiti korporat untuk tujuan jenayah.

Menurut Laporan Penilaian Bersama Pasukan Petugas Tindakan Kewangan (FATF) - Kumpulan Asia Pasifik Menge-

nai Pengubahan Wang Haram (APG) 2025 atau FATF-APG 2025, Malaysia mempunyai pemahaman yang kukuh dan mendalam mengenai risiko penyalahgunaan syarikat dan pengaturtuan undang-undang berkaitan.

Pemahaman itu diterjemahkan melalui pelaksanaan langkah pencegahan yang lebih ketat dan berkesan, memastikan struktur korporat tidak disalahgunakan untuk tujuan haram.

Kerajaan dilaporkan melaksanakan pendekatan 'pelbagai serampang' (multi-pronged

approach) bagi memastikan maklumat mengenai pemilik sebenar syarikat adalah tepat, terkini dan boleh diakses pihak berkuasa.

Pendekatan berkenaan melibatkan kerjasama erat Suruhanjaya Syarikat Malaysia (SSM), Lembaga Perkhidmatan Kewangan Labuan (Labuan FSA) dan institusi kewangan tempatan.

Pengawasan turut diperluas kepada golongan profesional seperti setiausaha syarikat, syarikat amanah Labuan dan pene-
gang amanah profesional, yang kini berperanan sebagai 'penjaga

pintu' (gatekeepers).

Mereka bertanggungjawab memastikan tiada elemen jenayah menyusup masuk dalam penubuhan syarikat, sekali gus mengekang aktiviti kolar putih sebelum ia berlaku.

Laporan itu juga menekankan pengharaman penggunaan saham pembawa (bearer shares), yang sebelum ini kerap digunakan untuk menyembunyikan identiti pemilik sebenar sesuatu aset atau syarikat.

Langkah itu memudahkan pihak berkuasa menjejak aliran wang haram dan meningkatkan

keberkesanan siasatan jenayah kewangan.

Malah menurut laporan berkenaan, sistem pendaftaran syarikat kini menuntut maklumat pemilikan benefisial dikemas kini secara berkala.

Langkah berkenaan membolehkan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) dan Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM) mengakses data penting dengan pantas ketika menjalankan siasatan, sekali gus mempercepat tindakan terhadap aktiviti yang mencurigakan.

‘Tak halang bisnes, tetapi daftar dahulu’

PETALING JAYA – Persatuan Homestay Malaysia mencadangkan supaya ada pihak kawal selia prosedur operasi standard (SOP) pengoperasian rumah persendirian dijadikan penginapan sewaan bermalam untuk memastikan pemilik mematuhi peraturan ditetapkan.

Presidennya, Datuk Sahariman Hamdan berkata, langkah itu juga bagi membolehkan rumah-rumah persendirian yang dijadikan sewaan bermalam ini beroperasi secara sah serta mempunyai lesen.

“Siapa kena *take care* (ambil tahu pengoperasian), sudah tentu (sebagai contoh) majlis atau pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) atau pihak bandar raya. Kita tak halang perniagaan, tak halang bisnes kecil, tapi kena ada sistem.

“Ia untuk memudahkan pemantauan, tak boleh sesuka hati (jalankan perniagaan),” katanya kepada *Kosmo!* ketika diminta mengulas aduan segelintir penduduk susulan ada pemilik kediaman membenarkan penganjuran majlis di *homestay* mereka.

Tindakan itu menimbulkan gangguan kepada penduduk setempat termasuk dari segi ke-

bersihan dan masalah tempat letak kenderaan di satu-satu kawasan perumahan.

Sahariman berkata, masyarakat terkeliru konsep inap desa atau *homestay* yang mana sepatutnya ia beroperasi di kampung dengan peserta tinggal bersama hos iaitu keluarga angkat.

Katanya, bagi Persatuan Homestay Malaysia pula, mereka mempunyai ahli-ahli dari 244 kampung seluruh negara serta mempunyai lesen inap desa sekali gus beroperasi secara sah.

“Rakyat tak tahu maksud *homestay* sebenar ialah tinggal bersama keluarga angkat di kampung, begitu juga konsep *Kampungstay* iaitu di kampung.

“Jika di kawasan bandar dan taman perumahan ini bukan ahli kita. Bukan kita nak tutup perniagaan, cuma kena ada SOP, lesen khas, berdaftar dengan Suruhanjaya Syarikat Malaysia atau PBT misalnya.

“Orang nak berniaga kita tak pernah sekat, tapi pastikan supaya ia berdaftar.

“Jadi ada peraturan, contohnya jangan mengganggu jiran dan sebagainya,” tambah Shariman.

大部分文具價格受到稅務影響，已在數月前調漲。

政府擴大SST徵稅範圍 文具價恐再喊漲

(勞勿、关丹、文德甲、哥打峇魯11日讯) 政府扩大销售与服务税(SST)征收范围，令部分文具早在数月前已调涨10%左右，导致教学及学习费用上涨，而目前商家继续观望文具价格走势，仍未知是否因来临新年，文具价格再次喊涨。

政府自今年7月1日实施销售与服务税扩大课税范围后，宣布所有纳入课税范围的纸张及文具售价调涨10%。记者走访各文具店，业者表示文具在年中期间曾涨价，价格在近数月来依然有多次调整，但起涨的幅度并不大，目前也未接获供应商通知明年度开学前，是否还会有变动。

顧客不介意微調

旁勿升文具店女东主覃女士(52岁)说，大部分文具已在今年7月份调涨10%，但为了留住顾客，他们自行吸纳涨幅及薄利多销，仅微调价，举例10令吉的文具，经10%调涨后是11令吉，但她仅微调数仙。

“若是微调数仙，顾客不会太介意，因为大家都知道，如今是受百货上涨影响所致，目前也未获供应商通知是否有另轮涨幅。”

她说，经济不景气，文具门市生意冲击大，加上网卖带来巨大竞争，生意难做，所以文具来货涨价，她也仅能微调价留住顾客。

關丹 家長恐承擔更高開銷

文具及纸张价格上涨，家长开学预算恐面临新一轮压力。

彭亨文具书业协会会长拿督郑东星受访时指出，文具属于小金额商品，即使微税，上涨幅度不大，但真正贵的还是纸张。

他说，市场上普遍使用的纸张已从每包18令吉调涨至接近20令吉。由于纸张属于各层面需求，包括学生、办公室及政府部门，因此涨价影响范围广泛。

他指出，业者不能随意调整价格，只能随市场走势调整。但他也坦言，随着目前文具与纸张价格上涨，明年开学季家长难免需要承担更高开销。

“刚入学的学生一定需要购买新文具，因此当前文具与纸张涨价的情况下，明年开学季势必会让部分家长承担更大的负担。”

他透露，文具市场近年来未呈现“冷静”的趋势，涨价后需求未见明显恢复，许多文具店被迫多元化经营，包括售卖饮料等，以维持生计。

不过，他指出，每年开学季仍会出现短暂的购买潮，但随后消费便会趋于平淡，这是文具业长期以来的常态。

文德甲广场太平洋霸级市场文具用品价格维持。

另外，书店店员哈娜(21岁)说，文具货品价格每月都有起落，依品牌而异，但幅度仅是数仙，并不显著。

她说，一些A4纸张品牌为了刺激买气，最近也有折扣促销活动，且在州政府推动的“繁荣促销”下，文具还能享有半价折扣。

“每当有价格调整，总行会在系统中进行通知，但最近尚未接到新一轮的价格调整通知。”

她说，最近登门购买文具的顾客有增加，当中有些学生已开始为明年度的开学做准备，包括购买书包、文具等。

哥打峇魯

旺嘉哈末

大部分仍保持原價

虽然政府今年7月宣布扩大销售与服务税征收范围，所有被纳入课税范围内的纸张和文具售价会调涨10%，但目前大部分文具仍保持原价。

哥打峇魯文具批發店員工劉秀妮指出，由于纸张被列入SST徵稅範圍，部分厂家有调整售价，造成纸张类产品出现微涨的情况。

她指出，除了纸张，一些与纸张相关的产品，价格也有少许调整，涨幅则视产品种类而定。不过这也取决于厂商是否可自行吸納成本。



劉秀妮在整理架子的簿子时说，大部分文具都保持原價。

她指出，预计在明年新年期间，与纸张相关的物品，价格可能调整。目前文具及纸张的需求量一般，或许接近学校假期。

她说，家长一般都会选择在接近开学时，才来采购，有些甚至会在开学两周内才购买。其实，除了纸张之外，大部分物品及文具都保持原价。

另外，文具店员工旺嘉哈末指出，或许学校假期即将来临，许多消费者都会在新学年开始采购，因此市场消费一般。他说，店内所售卖的文具，价格都是随著总行而定。不过，他透露，目前大部分是保持原价。

文德甲

未出現調幅現象

尽管政府今年7月宣布扩大销售与服务税征收范围，包括文具用品在内，但目前市场未掀起调涨。

文德甲广场太平洋霸级市场高级主管黄玉凤受访时指出，目前文具价格依然维持原有售价，并无出现调幅现象。

她坦言，由于市场竞争激烈，尤其是连锁店林立，导致该霸级市场的文具用品销量平平。

“平日买气一般，新学年前夕可能会迎来一波采购潮，预计12月底至次年1月初，才是文具真正的旺季。”

另一家连锁店店员受访时也透露，目前总部尚未发出任何调整价格的指示，店内文具维持全年价格。

她指出，文具是长期需求商品，平日仍有民众选购，但数量不多，一般是孩子文具损坏或用完后才购买新的，每逢开学前夕才是销售高峰。

“除非是公司企业购买，数量则会较大。”
