KPDN serbu premis tipu ketulenan emas

3,545 keping logam dicop AU 999.9 disita dalam Ops Tulen

Kuala Lumpur: Taktik premis menjual emas melalui saluran media sosial dengan menipu tahap ketulenan terbongkar apabila diserbu Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) yang menyita 3,545 keping logam emas pelbagai bentuk bernilai RM82,725 menerusi Operasi Khas Ops Tulen di Pusat Perniagaan Kuchai Lama, di sini baru-baru ini.

KPDN dalam kenyataan semalam, memaklumkan operasi di bawah Akta Perihal Dagangan 2011 (Akta 730) itu dilaksanakan enam pegawai penguat kuasa bahagian penguat kuasa kementerian selepas premis berkenaan disyaki menjual produk emas yang tidak menepati stan-

dard ketulenan melalui saluran media sosial.

"Hasil ujian menggunakan peralatan pendarfluor sinar-X (XRF) ke atas syiling emas yang dibeli mendapati kandungan emas sebenar lebih rendah berbanding ketulenan yang dicop iaitu AU 999.9, dengan bacaan purata sekitar 77 peratus," menurut kenyataan itu.

Pembekal kepada peruncit

Pemeriksaan lanjut mendapati premis berkenaan adalah pembekal kepada peruncit yang memasarkan produk emas dalam talian, manakala produk dipamerkan di premis itu sama seperti diiklankan di media sosial.

Ujian ke atas emas yang disita pula menunjukkan kandungan emas berbeza-beza antara 80 peratus hingga 98 peratus bagi setiap kepingan seberat 0.01 gram.

Sehubungan itu, premis terbabit disyaki melakukan kesalahan di bawah Seksyen 5(1)(a) Akta Perihal Dagangan 2011 kerana membuat perihal dagangan palsu berkaitan standard ketulenan barangan logam berharga.

Selain emas, beberapa pera-

latan dan dokumen turut disita bagi membantu siasatan.

KPDN memaklumkan tindakan undang-undang akan diambil terhadap mana-mana pihak yang membuat perihal dagangan palsu mengenai kandungan, jenis atau nama barangan di bawah Seksyen 5(1)(c) Akta 730.

Bagi individu, kesalahan pertama boleh dikenakan denda sehingga RM250,000 atau penjara maksimum tiga tahun atau kedua-duanya, manakala bagi kesalahan kedua atau berikutnya denda sehingga RM500,000 atau penjara maksimum lima tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Bagi syarikat pula, denda sehingga RM500,000 boleh dikenakan bagi kesalahan pertama dan sehingga RM1 juta bagi kesalahan kedua atau berikutnya.

KPDN menegaskan komitmen kementerian untuk terus mempergiatkan penguatkuasaan bagi membanteras amalan perniagaan yang mengelirukan dan menipu pengguna, khususnya melibatkan penjualan barangan logam berharga. BERNAMA

Taktik sebuah premis menjual produk logam berharga iaitu emas melalui saluran media sosial dengan menipu tahap ketulenan terbongkar apabila diserbu Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN), baru-baru ini. Dalam serbuan berkenaan, KPDN merampas 3,545 keping logam emas pelbagai bentuk yang ditandakan

dengan standard ketulenan tertentu serta beberapa peralatan dan dokumen berkaitan bagi tujuan siasatan lanjut dengan anggaran nilai keseluruhan rampasan adalah sebanyak RM82,725. KPDN berkata, serbuan dijalankan Bahagian Penguatkuasa KPDN menerusi Operasi Khas Ops Tulen di Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur mengikut Akta Perihal Dagangan 2011 (Akta 730). Menurut, operasi ini membabitkan enam pegawai penguat kuasa dan dijalankan ke atas sebuah premis perniagaan di Pusat

Perniagaan Kuchai Lama. "Pemeriksaan mendapati premis berkenaan menjual produk logam berharga iaitu emas melalui saluran media sosial. RM82,000 in gold seized over false purity claims

PUTRAJAYA: The Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry has seized gold pieces worth over RM82,000 in a special operation in Kuala Lumpur over alleged misrepresentation of purity standards.

Its Enforcement Division said the seizure, conducted during an operation codenamed Op Tulen under the Trade Descriptions Act 2011, took place at a business premise in Pusat Perniagaan Kuchai Lama.

"The operation involved six enforcement officers, and they found that the premises was supplying gold products to retailers and promoting the items for sale through social

media platforms.

"Tests using X-ray fluorescence equipment on a gold bar purchased by ministry officers showed the actual gold content was significantly lower than the purity level stamped on the item, which indicated AU 999.9," it said in a statement yesterday.

The division added that the average gold content recorded was only about 77 per cent, which did not match the advertised standard.

"Further checks showed that gold products displayed at the premises were the same as those promoted online.

"Subsequent tests on seized items showed varying gold con-

tent ranging between 80 per cent and 98 per cent for each piece weighing 0.01g," it said, adding that the premises was being investigated under Section 5(1)(a) of the Trade Descriptions Act 2011 for alleged violations of standards of purity for goods made from precious metals.

It added that 3,545 pieces of gold in various forms worth RM82,750 were seized.

The ministry warned that any party found making false trade descriptions regarding the content, type or name of goods could be charged under Section 5(1)(c) of the same act.

Individuals convicted of a first offence can be fined up to

RM250,000 or jailed for up to three years, or both.

For subsequent offences, the fine can reach RM500,000 or imprisonment of up to five

years, or both.

Companies face fines of up to RM500,000 for a first offence and up to RM1 million for repeat offences.

Over 3,500 pieces of impure gold items seized

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 3,545 impure gold items were seized from a business premises at the Kuchai Lama Business Centre by enforcement officers from the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry recently.

According to the ministry, six enforcement officers from its Enforcement Division carried out the operation after the premises was suspected of selling gold products that did not meet purity standards via social media platforms.

“Test results using X-ray

Fluorescence equipment on the gold coins purchased found that the actual gold content was much lower than the stamped purity of AU 999.9, with an average reading of around 77%,” it said.

Investigations revealed that the premises served as a supplier to a retailer marketing the same gold products online.

The items on display at the premises matched those advertised on social media, the statement added, Bernama reported.

Tests carried out on the seized items revealed that their gold con-

tent varied between 80% and 98% for each piece weighing 0.01g.

Several equipment and documents were also seized to assist further investigations.

The ministry said the business operators were suspected of committing an offence under Section 5 of the Trade Descriptions Act for making false trade descriptions regarding the purity standards of precious metal goods.

Individuals convicted under this provision can be fined up to RM250,000 or imprisonment for a maximum of three years or both,

while companies could be subjected a maximum RM500,000 fine.

The ministry said it would intensify enforcement operations to curb misleading and deceptive business practices, especially involving the sale of precious metal products.

内贸部检举旧古仔商业中心 起3545件不符纯度黄金

(吉隆坡 18 日讯) 国内贸易及生活成本部日前在旧古仔商业中心展开“纯正特别行动”(Ops Tulen), 起获估计价值8万2725 令吉的 3545 件各种形式金块。

内贸部今天发文告说, 随着有关场所通过社交媒体疑售卖不符合纯度标准的黄金产品, 该部门执法组 6 名执法官员在 2011 年商品说明法令 (730 法令) 之下展开执法行动。

文告指出, 当局在使用 X 射线荧光 (XRF) 器材对所购买的金币检测后, 发现实际含金量远低于标示的 AU 999.9 纯度, 平均读数仅为约 77%。

它说, 进一步检查发现, 该场所向在线销售相同黄金产品的零售商供货, 对起获的黄金进行的检测显示, 每件重0.01黄金的含金量介于80%至98%之间。

“有鉴于此, 该场所涉嫌对贵金属的纯度标准作出虚假商品说明, 抵触 730 法令第 5(1)(a)条文。”

文告提到, 除了黄金之外, 执法人员也扣押多个器材和相关, 以协助进一步调查。

它说, 内贸部对就商品的成分、种类或名称作出虚假商品说明任何人采取法律行动, 在 730 法令第 5 (1) (c) 条文之下, 初犯个人可被判处高达 25 万令吉罚款或最长 3 年监禁, 或两者兼施。

至于初犯公司, 则可被判罚 50 万令吉, 第二次或接下来继续违法, 可被罚款高达 100 万令吉。

KPDN said legal action will be taken against any party who makes false trade descriptions regarding the content, type or name of the goods under Section 5(1)(c) of Act 730.

For individuals, the first offence

can be fined up to RM250,000 or imprisonment for a maximum of three years or both, while for the second or subsequent offence, a fine of up to RM500,000 or imprisonment for a maximum of five years or both.

For companies, a fine of up to RM500,000 can be imposed for the first offence and up to RM1 million for the second or subsequent offences.

KPDN stressed the ministry's commitment to continue intensifying enforcement to combat misleading and deceptive business practices, especially involving the sale of precious metal products. — Bernama
