## Measures to address cost of living pressures

KUALA LUMPUR:

The government remains committed to addressing cost of living pressures through sustained intervention measures, including price stabilisation and efforts to boost household income, said Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali (pic).

He said the concerns raised by several Members of Parliament ranged from general anxieties over rising expenses to specific matters under the purview of KPDN and other agencies.

He said the government takes seriously issues such as income levels that are insufficient to meet living costs, rising prices of food, housing and education, as well as the broader social security implications stemming from economic pressures.

"KPDN welcomes calls for a more comprehensive approach in addressing cost



of living challenges.

"While key economic indicators – including inflation rates, findings from the Household Income and Expenditure Survey, and the Gini coefficient – showed positive trends, the government would continue its intervention and mitigation measures to help the rakyat cope.

"This is implemented through a two-pronged approach: ensuring price stability of essential goods and services, and increasing disposable income among the people," he said.

Armizan who is also Papar Member of Parliament said this during his winding-up speech on the Motion of Thanks for the Royal Address at Dewan Negara on Tuesday.

He said measures to stabilise prices include strict monitoring of supply chains and enforcement actions to maintain a fair, transparent and competitive market ecosystem, as well as targeted interventions to improve public access to daily necessities.

At the same time, he said the government is implementing various policies

and programmes aimed at stimulating income growth, including creating job opportunities, raising the minimum wage, introducing a progressive wage policy, empowering entrepreneurship, and providing targeted cash assistance, among others.

Armizan said cost of living issues are being coordinated through the National Action Council on Cost of Living (NACCOL), which adopts a whole-of-government approach involving multiple ministries.

He said the council addresses key clusters such as food, health, education, housing, transport, income and utilities, and the agenda would be further strengthened through a whole-of-nation approach involving the private sector and other stakeholders.

Under the 13th Malaysia Plan (RMK13), Armizan added, these efforts would be reinforced through a Strategy to Strengthen Cost of Living Management, supported by the National Cost of Living Action Plan 2026-2030, which is expected to be finalised in the second quarter of this year.



## KPDN exploring transport solution for MADANI Rahmah Sales in interior areas, says Fuziah

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) is studying the possibility of appointing a transport company as the operator of the MADANI Rahmah Sales Programme (PJRM) in the interior areas of Sabah and Sarawak.

Deputy Minister Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh said that the move was seen as a solution to the constraints faced by existing operators, who found it difficult to reach the areas due to high logistics costs.

"The programme sometimes

does not reach interior areas because operators are unwilling to travel there due to transportation cost challenge. That is why they often reject (requests to go to interiors).

"So we are looking into whether these transporters can become Rahmah Sales operators since they already receive logistics subsidies from the ministry," she said during an oral question-and-answer session at the Dewan Negara on Thursday.

She said this in reply to a supplementary question from Senator Abun Sui Anyit, who

asked about a more targeted mechanism to stabilise the prices of basic necessities in interior areas, including the potential involvement of cooperatives and local transport operators.

Fuziah further explained that KPDN had set aside RM67 million this year under the Port-to-Port initiative for the Standardisation of Prices of Basic Necessities Programme in Sabah, Sarawak, and Labuan.

She said the subsidy was intended to cover the cost of shipping goods from Port Klang to major ports such as Kuching

and Kota Kinabalu, to ensure that the prices of items like sugar and onions remain stable.

"The government has also allocated RM250 million this year under the Essential Goods Distribution Program for interior areas, covering 1,570 locations identified as needing Point of Sale (POS) facilities, of which 1,480 are in Sabah and Sarawak.

"This allocation is given to transporters appointed through a tender process to deliver basic necessities directly to POS in the interior," she said. — Bernama



# Transport operators eyed for remote area deliveries

**K**UALA LUMPUR: Sabah and Sarawak may see a transport company appointed to operate the MADANI Rahmah Sales Programme (PJM) in their interior areas, as the initiative is currently under study.

Deputy Minister of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN), Datuk Dr Fuziah Salleh, said that the move was seen as a solution to the constraints faced by existing operators, who found it difficult to reach the areas due to high logistics costs.

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Meanwhile, Fuziah said that KPDN had completed a Price Stability Study and set up a technical working group involving the federal government, state governments, and industry players to develop a long-term price stability strategy.

She said the ministry would also

## Perak food rescue team back in action at 12 sites

A RAMADAN bazaar food rescue group is continuing its mission of distributing unsold food to the needy and saving it from ending in the bin.

Perak MySaveFood@Ramadan (MSF) project manager Puteri Aisyah Megat Shariffudin said the initiative, which aimed to create awareness of food wastage, had entered its sixth year, reported Bernama.

She said that on the first day of the programme, which was the fourth day of Ramadan, 126kg of surplus food and beverages were collected from the Taman Cempaka and Silibin bazaars in Ipoh.

The total comprised 58kg of food and 68kg of drinks.

Puteri Aisyah said both bazaars were small with about 40 stalls each, but the surplus food recorded was quite high.

"On average, one stall generates around 1kg of surplus food.

"Every year we conduct awareness campaigns among traders.

"But based on our observation, awareness remains low despite the programme having been implemented for several years now.

"One possible factor is that traders change from year to year," she said.

This year's programme in Perak involves 12 bazaars, compared to 15 last year.

The MSF@Ramadan in Perak

is being conducted in collaboration with Ipoh City Council (MBI), the Perak Tengah and Tanjong Malim district councils and Teluk Intan Municipal Council.

Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry is pitching in through its "Gerakan Pengguna Siswa" volunteer programme involving university students.

"To strengthen awareness, we are also looking at issuing a 'red card' to stalls that repeatedly generate a lot of food surplus," Puteri Aisyah said.

The MySaveFood@Ramadan programme in Perak is in its sixth year. — Bernama

## Wholesaler fined for poor stock records in Labuan

LABUAN: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Labuan has taken action against a wholesaler for failing to maintain proper stock records of controlled goods such as cooking oil and sugar.

During an enforcement operation under Ops Pantau Bekalan, inspections revealed incomplete transaction details, including missing dates, quantities, prices and supplier or buyer information.

Labuan KPDN Director Junaidah Arbain said the offence violates the Control of Supplies Regulations 1974 under the Control of Supplies Act 1961.

Licensed traders must maintain and regularly update stock books, and failure to do so can result in fines of up to RM1 million, imprisonment of up to three years, or both.

Companies may face fines up to RM2 million, rising to RM5 million for repeat offences.

Junaidah added that KPDN will continue strict monitoring and enforcement against violators.

## 33 peniaga bazar Ramadan patuh undang-undang

Hasil pemeriksaan dilaksanakan Ops Pantau 2026 oleh KPDN Cawangan Semporna

KUNAK: Seramai 33 peniaga di Bazar Ramadan Kunak didapati mematuhi undang-undang yang dikuatkuasakan selepas pemeriksaan dilaksanakan menerusi Ops Pantau 2026 oleh Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Cawangan Semporna, semalam.

Operasi berkenaan turut dijalankan bersama Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) dan Majlis Daerah Kunak bagi memastikan pematuan undang-undang perdagangan serta peraturan kebersihan makanan sepanjang bulan Ramadan.

Ketua Cawangan KPDN Semporna, Satunlucy Lamioh @ Lamidah berkata,

pemeriksaan dilakukan ke atas 33 premis dan hasilnya mendapati kesemua peniaga mematuhi undang-undang di bawah bidang kuasa KPDN.

Katanya, operasi itu bertujuan memastikan peniaga mematuhi peraturan termasuk aspek penandaan harga serta amalan perdagangan yang adil.

"Selain KPDN, pihak KKM turut menjalankan pemeriksaan terhadap 33 premis dan telah mengeluarkan satu kompaun bernilai RM200 di bawah Peraturan-Peraturan Kebersihan Makanan 2009 atas kesalahan ketidakpatuhan aspek kebersihan makanan," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

Dalam pada itu, menurutnya, Majlis Daerah Kunak turut melaksanakan pemeriksaan melibatkan

semakan lesen operasi serta kad kesihatan pengendali makanan bagi memastikan semua peniaga mematuhi syarat yang ditetapkan.

"Operasi pemantauan akan terus dipergiatkan dari semasa ke semasa bagi memastikan pematuan undang-undang selain melindungi kepentingan pengguna," katanya.

## 内贸部斗湖展开联合执法行动 6 间商店违规被取缔



国内贸易及生活成本部斗湖分局在鱼市场检查渔贩是否有“吃称头”。(18D)

(斗湖 5 日讯)国内贸易及生活成本部(KPDN)斗湖分局周三联合多家执法单位,在斗湖鱼市场、丹绒巴剎以及斋戒月市集展开综合执法行动,共检查 60 间商店,其中 6 间因违规被采取行动。

斗湖 KPDN 执法组主任莫哈末罗里阿里曼表示,此次行动是与卫生部(KKM)执法组、马来西亚皇家警察(PDRM)以及斗湖市议会(MPT)执法组联合展开,旨在确保商家遵守价格标示规定,并使用合法及仍在验证期限内的计量秤。他说,执法人员在行动中检查了 60 间营业场所,大部分商家都遵守法律规定,正确展示商品价格,并使用仍在有效验证期内的秤重器具。

“不过,执法人员仍发现 6 间商店违规,包括未展示价格标签,以及使用已过期的秤重器具进行商业交易。”

他指出,相关违规行为已在《2011 年价格控制及反暴利法令》及《1972 年秤量与度量法令》下被采取行动,并当场向有关商家开出罚单。他说,这些案件的罚款总额为 1300 令吉。此外,执法人员在检查过程中也发现,一些展示出售的商品没有标示现金售价,这同样违反《2020 年价格控制及反暴利(商品价格标示及服务收费)条例》。他指出,一旦罪成,个人最高可被罚款 1 万令吉或罚款

式和解最高 5000 令吉;公司或机构则最高可被罚款 2 万令吉或罚款式和解最高 1 万令吉。

莫哈末罗里表示,斗湖 KPDN 将继续与相关执法机构加强监督与检查,特别是在节庆期间,以确保商业活动遵守法律及商业道德,从而保障消费者权益。

## MACP perkenal garis panduan AI

**BADAN** Perlindungan Hak Cipta Muzik Berhad (MACP) memperkenalkan Garis Panduan Mengenai Kecerdasan Buatan (AI) bagi melindungi, memperjuangkan hak dan memelihara kepentingan pencipta muzik di negara ini.

MACP dalam kenyataan berkata langkah itu bertujuan memastikan ekosistem muzik tempatan kekal dilindungi di bawah kerangka undang-undang sedia ada dalam landskap teknologi AI yang berkembang pesat dan berpotensi menimbulkan cabaran baharu berkaitan hak cipta, pemilikan serta pampasan yang adil dan setara bagi pencipta muzik.

"MACP menegaskan bahawa hak cipta merupakan hak eksklusif yang terhasil daripada daya kreatif dan sentuhan manusia.

"Garis panduan baharu ini menetapkan bahawa hanya karya asli yang dihasilkan sepenuhnya oleh pencipta manusia layak didaftarkan dengan MACP dan menerima pembayaran royalti.

"Oleh itu MACP tidak mengiktiraf sebarang karya yang terhasil sepenuhnya atau sebahagiannya dengan bantuan AI," kata kenyataan itu.

Kenyataan itu menambah garis panduan AI MACP ini selaras dengan pendirian kerajaan dan mengambil kira keperluan untuk mengekalkan perlindungan hak cipta manusia dalam teknologi AI.

"Bagi melaksanakan garis panduan ini MACP memperkenalkan mekanisme pengesahan mandatori di portal ahli 'myKarya'.

"Ahli MACP perlu mengesahkan bahawa karya yang didaftarkan adalah asli dan bukan dihasilkan melalui AI.

"Sebarang deklarasi palsu yang melibatkan karya janaan AI akan berhadapan dengan tindakan tegas termasuk pembatalan pendaftaran karya serta penahanan pembayaran royalti," ujar kenyataan sama.

Kenyataan itu menambah latihan atau penajaan kandungan AI oleh syarikat atau penyedia perkhidmatan AI berpotensi melibatkan karya yang dilindungi hak cipta, termasuk karya muzik milik ahli-ahli MACP.

"Oleh itu MACP berharap peruntukan khas bagi Perlombongan Teks dan Data (TDM) yang bakal digubal oleh kerajaan tidak memberikan sebarang pengecualian yang menjejaskan hak pemegang hak cipta.

"Mana-mana pihak ketiga termasuk syarikat AI yang ingin menggunakan repertoire MACP untuk latihan AI atau penajaan kandungan mesti memperoleh persetujuan bertulis terlebih dahulu serta memasuki perjanjian

lesen dengan MACP.

"Penggunaan tanpa kebenaran karya MACP dalam pembangunan atau output AI dianggap sebagai pencerobohan hak cipta dan akan tertakluk kepada tindakan undang-undang," jelasnya.

Sebagai Badan Pengurusan Kolektif (CMO), MACP berkata ia komited untuk terus melindungi hak cipta dan kepentingan pencipta muzik di Malaysia.

"Komitmen berterusan ini bukanlah untuk menolak teknologi, sebaliknya sebagai langkah proaktif MACP bagi memperjuangkan hak dan memelihara kepentingan pencipta agar AI tidak merampas hak asasi pencipta muzik," katanya.

Sementara itu badan itu menyambut baik inisiatif kerajaan untuk menggubal Rang Undang-Undang (RUU) Tadbir Urus AI.

Baru-baru ini di Parlimen Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim menegaskan bahawa langkah itu bertujuan mewujudkan akauntabiliti serta etika, selain memastikan undang-undang sedia ada terus terpakai dan boleh dilaksanakan.

"MACP menegaskan komitmennya untuk memastikan perlindungan terhadap pencipta tempatan terus terpelihara selari dengan keperluan mengimbangi kemajuan teknologi.

"Kami juga bersedia menyertai proses libat urus penggubalan rang undang-undang tersebut serta memberi input bagi memperkukuh tadbir urus AI di negara ini khususnya berkaitan hak cipta karya muzik," katanya.

Susulan itu Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali turut memaklumkan bahawa di bawah Akta Hak Cipta 1987, perlindungan hak cipta hanya diberikan kepada orang yang berkecualan dan karya tersebut mestilah hasil daripada usaha yang mencukupi daripada manusia.

Oleh itu karya yang dijana oleh AI tidak layak memperoleh perlindungan hak cipta mengikut undang-undang sedia ada di Malaysia.

Armizan turut dipetik berkata KPDN melalui Perbadanan Harta Intelekt Malaysia (MyIPO) sedang meneliti keperluan untuk mengemas kini undang-undang sedia ada.

"MACP turut menyokong kenyataan Menteri KPDN bahawa pemilik hak cipta asal berhak mengambil tindakan undang-undang sekiranya sesuatu karya janaan AI didapati melanggar hak cipta," tambah kenyataan itu. - **Kazalinah Kamaludin**

## GOF scores RM4.85 mln smuggled goods haul in Bau raid

**KUCHING:** The Sarawak General Operations Force (GOF) seized smuggled goods worth some RM4.85 million during an Op Taring Bravo operation in Bau on March 2.

Brigade commander SAC Lim Bak Phai said five local men aged between 23 and 52 were arrested for allegedly being involved in the storage and smuggling of various goods without valid documents or permits.

"Inspections at the premises led to the seizure of 24,975 kilogrammes of red onions, 3,383kg of cooking oil, 62,190kg of rice, 125 boxes of various medicines, and 16,080kg of frozen meat," he said in a statement yesterday.

Also seized were three lorries

and three containers, bringing the total value of the confiscated items to about RM4.85 million."

Lim said the raid was jointly carried out with the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living, Customs Department, Health Ministry, Department of Veterinary Services, and other agencies.

"The suspects and seized items have been handed over to the relevant agencies for further investigation and action under the applicable laws," he added.

He advised the public to comply with existing regulations and ensure all valid documents and permits are obtained before engaging in any trading or transportation of goods.



# PGA Sarawak rampas pelbagai barangan seludup RM4.85 juta

Serbuan ke atas premis di Bau turut menahan lima lelaki tempatan

KUCHING: Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) Briged Sarawak merampas pelbagai barangan tanpa dokumen sah bernilai kira-kira RM4.85 juta dalam serbuan menerusi Ops Taring Bravo, Isnin lalu.

Komander Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) Briged Sarawak SAC Lim Bak Phai berkata, serbuan dijalankan Cawangan Risik Batalion 11 PGA Kuching ke atas sebuah premis di daerah Bau.

Menurutnya, operasi itu turut menahan lima lelaki warga tempatan berumur antara 23 dan 52 tahun yang disyaki terlibat dalam aktiviti penyimpanan serta penyeludupan barangan tanpa dokumen atau permit sah.

"Hasil pemeriksaan membawa kepada rampasan sebanyak 24,975 kilogram bawang merah, 3,383 kilo-

gram minyak masak, 62,190 kilogram beras, 125 kotak pelbagai jenis ubat-ubatan serta 16,080 kilogram daging sejuk beku.

"Turut dirampas tiga lori dan tiga kontena dengan nilai keseluruhan rampasan dianggarkan berjumlah RM4.85 juta," katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

dapat aktiviti penyeludupan dadah di lokasi serbuan.

"Kesemua tangkapan dan rampasan telah diserahkan kepada agensi berkaitan untuk tindakan serta siasatan lanjut di bawah undang-undang yang berkuat kuasa," katanya.

Dalam pada itu, beliau menasihatkan orang awam supaya sentiasa mematuhi undang-undang serta memastikan semua dokumen dan permit yang sah diperoleh sebelum menjalankan sebarang aktiviti perdagangan atau pengangkutan barangan.
