# 15,881 PJRM di seluruh negara hingga 30 Jun

**Kementerian** Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) telah melaksanakan 15,881 Program Jualan Rahmah MADANI (PJRM) di seluruh negara bagi tempoh 1 Januari hingga 30 Jun tahun ini.

Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup, Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali, berkata secara keseluruhannya, pelaksanaan PJRM meliputi semua 600 kawasan Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) serta seluruh 40 Zon di Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya, Kuala Lumpur dan Labuan.

“Kerajaan komited untuk meningkatkan kekerapan penganjuran PJRM di seluruh negara. Ini sejajar dengan maklum balas positif yang diterima daripada pelbagai pihak,” katanya pada sesi soal jawab di Dewan Rakyat.

Beliau menjawab pertanyaan Datuk Iskandar Dzulkarnain Abdul Khalid (PN-Kuala Kangsar) yang meminta jumlah pelaksanaan terkini PJRM mengikut kawasan DUN di seluruh negara dan bertanya kesediaan KPDN untuk meningkatkan kekerapan pelaksanaan PJRM bagi meredakan kos sara hidup rakyat.

## Lebih 15,800 PJRM di seluruh negara

Sebanyak 15,881 siri Program Jualan Rahmah Madani (PJRM) dilaksanakan di seluruh negara bagi tempoh 1 Januari hingga 30

Jun tahun ini, mencerminkan komitmen kerajaan memperluaskan akses rakyat kepada barangan keperluan pada harga berpatutan.

Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup, Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali (**gambar**), berkata pelaksanaan itu meliputi semua 600 kawasan Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) di seluruh negara serta 40 zon di Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya dan Labuan.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika menjawab soalan Datuk Iskandar Dzulkarnain Abdul Khalid (PN-Kuala Kangsar) semasa sesi Dewan Rakyat.

Menurutnya, sepanjang tempoh sama, sebanyak 1,304 siri PJRM dianjurkan di Perak, termasuk 43 siri di Parlimen Kuala Kangsar membabitkan 21 siri di DUN Bukit Chandan dan 22 siri di DUN Manong.

"Rekod menunjukkan sebanyak 6,870 siri PJRM dilaksanakan pada 2023 sebelum meningkat kepada 12,419 siri pada 2024 dan melonjak kepada 25,708 siri sepanjang 2025.

"Bagi tahun ini, sasaran asal ditetapkan sebanyak 23,040 siri. Bagaimanapun, sasaran itu dinaikkan kepada 30,000 siri susulan pengumuman Perdana Menteri pada Mei lalu sebagai langkah intervensi kerajaan membantu rakyat menghadapi kesan krisis tenaga dan bekalan akibat konflik di Asia Barat," katanya.

Armizan berkata kerajaan akan terus meningkatkan kekerapan pengedaran PJRM sejajar dengan sambutan dan maklum balas positif daripada rakyat, disokong oleh peruntukan tambahan yang disalurkan setiap tahun.

Beliau berkata, selain meningkatkan jumlah pengedaran, kerajaan turut memperkukuh pelaksanaan PJRM menerusi lima pendekatan utama sejak pentadbiran Kerajaan Madani.

Menurutnya, pendekatan pertama ialah menginstitusikan PJRM sebagai program tetap kerajaan. Bermula 2024,



program itu dimasukkan secara rasmi dalam Belanjawan Tahunan Kerajaan dengan kod aktiviti serta peruntukan khusus di bawah agenda Payung Rahmah, berbeza dengan program jualan murah sebelum ini yang dilaksanakan secara bermusim.

"Pendekatan kedua ialah menetapkan sasaran tahunan dan jumlah pelaksanaan mengikut setiap DUN dan zon di seluruh negara bagi memastikan pengedaran lebih tersusun dan menyeluruh.

"Ketiga, kerajaan membuka ruang penyertaan lebih luas kepada syarikat, perniagaan dan koperasi sektor peruncitan sebagai rakan strategik. Sehingga 29 Jun 2026, seramai 2,695 rakan strategik peruncitan mengambil bahagian dalam pelaksanaan PJRM di seluruh negara.

"Pendekatan keempat melibatkan peluasan akses kepada rakyat menerusi tiga kaedah pelaksanaan iaitu jualan dalam premis, luar premis (statik) dan PJRM bergerak, selain pengedaran program bertema seperti musim perayaan, Hari Gaji dan musim pembukaan sekolah yang meliputi kawasan bandar, luar bandar serta pedalaman.

"Pendekatan kelima pula ialah memperkenalkan Takwim PJRM bermula 2025 bagi membolehkan orang ramai mengetahui lebih awal tarikh, masa dan lokasi pengedaran di setiap zon," katanya.

Beliau berkata inisiatif itu memudahkan rakyat merancang pembelian barangan keperluan lebih awal di lokasi berhampiran, sekali gus meningkatkan keberkesanan PJRM dalam membantu mengurangkan kos sara hidup.

Sehubungan itu, katanya, KPDN akan terus memperkasa PJRM sebagai antara instrumen utama kerajaan bagi memastikan rakyat menikmati bekalan barangan keperluan pada harga berpatutan di samping mengurangkan beban kos sara hidup.

## Over 15,000 Rahmah Sales held nationwide

THE Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) has rolled out 15,881 Rahmah Madani Sales Programme (PJRM) across the country between Jan 1 and June 30 this year.



Minister Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali (pic) confirmed that the programme has successfully covered all 600 state constituencies and all 40 Federal Territory zones in Putrajaya, Kuala Lumpur, and Labuan.

"The government is committed to increasing the frequency of PJRM nationwide, following positive feedback from various quarters," he told the Dewan Rakyat during a question-and-answer session Tuesday.

This came in reply to a question from Datuk Iskandar Dzulkarnain Abdul Khalid (PN-Kuala Kangsar) regarding the latest constituency-level data for the sales programme, and the ministry's capacity to increase event frequency to help ease the public's cost of living.

Armizan said the implementation of the sales programme has seen a significant year-on-year increase, rising from 6,870 sessions in 2023 to 12,419 in 2024, and reaching 25,708 in 2025.

He added that the initial target of 23,040 sessions for this year was revised to 30,000, following Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's announcement in May, which serves as an intervention measure against the energy and supply crisis triggered by the West Asia conflict.

Meanwhile, Armizan noted that the Madani Government has used five strategic approaches since 2023 to reinforce the programme, namely institutionalising the sales event as a permanent fixture in the annual national budget starting 2024, under its own activity code and specific funding under the "Payung Rahmah" agenda.

"The second measure establishes annual targets and scheduling frequencies for every constituency and zone. Unlike previous government bargain sales, which were purely ad hoc, this ensures a structured implementation," he said.

The third strategy, he said, focuses on private-sector integration, in which the government has actively engaged companies, businesses, and cooperatives from the retail sub-sector, securing 2,695 strategic retail partners as of June 29.

Armizan said the fourth approach focuses on expanding public access through three distinct delivery methods: in-store, open-air, and mobile sales as well as themed events tailored to festive seasons, paydays, and back-to-school periods, covering urban, rural, and remote areas. - Bernama

## Over 15,800 Rahmah MADANI sales held nationwide

**K**UALA LUMPUR: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) has rolled out 15,881 Rahmah MADANI Sales Programme (PIRM) across the country between Jan 1 and June 30 this year.

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"The fifth approach was the introduction of a PIRM calendar starting in 2025, providing the public with advance information on dates, times, and locations for every state constituency and zone nationwide. This allows people to check the schedule for their local area and plan their shopping ahead of time," he added. - BERNAMA

## Pemilik syarikat kereta didenda gagal patuhi award TTPM

KOTA KINABALU: Seorang pemilik perniagaan automobil didenda RM3,500 atau penjara tiga bulan oleh Mahkamah Majistret pada Selasa selepas mengaku bersalah gagal mematuhi award Tribunal Tuntutan Pengguna Malaysia (TTPM).

Mohd Khairul Afis John, 32, mengaku bersalah di hadapan Majistret Marilyn Kelvin kerana gagal mematuhi award tribunal bertarikh 28 Oktober 2025 dengan tidak memulangkan RM8,000 kepada penuntut, Asril Shamsuddin dalam tempoh 14 hari seperti yang diperintahkan.

Kesalahan itu dilakukan pada 11 November 2025 di premis Sanny Automobile, Pusat Komersial Bundusan.

Mohd Khairul didakwa mengikut Seksyen 117(1) Akta Perlindungan Pengguna 1999 yang memperuntukkan hukuman denda sehingga RM10,000 atau penjara sehingga dua tahun, atau keduanya sekali jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Mahkamah diberitahu bahawa pada 28 Oktober 2025 Presiden Tribunal Tuntutan Pengguna Malaysia mengarahkan Sanny Automobile selaku responden memulangkan RM8,000 kepada penuntut dalam tempoh 14 hari dari tarikh award dikeluarkan.

Bagaimanapun selepas responden

gagal mematuhi award tersebut penuntut membuat aduan ketidakpatuhan kepada Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) pada 18 November 2025 yang membawa kepada siasatan dan pendakwaan.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan oleh Pegawai Pendakwa KPDN Gunasegaran Krishan.

Lelaki mengaku tidak bersalah melanggar perintah pengawasan polis.

Dalam prosiding berasingan seorang lelaki berusia 37 tahun didakwa melanggar syarat perintah pengawasan polis apabila gagal berada di alamat berdaftar dalam tempoh waktu yang ditetapkan.

Edwin Eking mengaku tidak bersalah atas pertuduhan tidak berada di rumah beralamat di Taman Che Mei Lido antara jam 8 malam hingga 6 pagi walaupun tertakluk kepada perintah pengawasan polis di bawah Seksyen 15 Akta Pencegahan Jenayah 1959.

Kesalahan itu didakwa dilakukan kira-kira jam 12.30 tengah malam pada 14 Jun lalu.

Pertuduhan dikemukakan mengikut Seksyen 15 Akta Pencegahan Jenayah 1959 dan boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen 15(4) akta sama yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara antara dua hingga lima tahun jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Mahkamah menetapkan 12 Ogos depan untuk pengurusan kes praperbicaraan.

Tertuduh dibenarkan diikat jamin sebanyak RM10,000 dengan dua orang penjamin.

Sebagai syarat tambahan jaminan mahkamah turut mengarahkan Edwin melapor diri di balai polis sekali setiap bulan.

## Ignoring Consumer Tribunal award penalty

KOTA KINABALU: A Magistrate's Court on Tuesday fined an automobile business owner RM3,500, in default three months' jail for failing to comply with an award issued by the Malaysian Consumer Claims Tribunal.

Mohd Khairul Afis John, 32, pleaded guilty before Magistrate Marilyn Kelvin to failing to comply with a Tribunal award dated Oct 28, 2025.

He was ordered to refund RM8,000 to a claimant, Asril Shamsuddin, within 14 days but failed to do so.

The offence was committed on Nov 11, 2025, at Sanny Automobile, Bundusan Commercial Centre, near here.

Under Section 117(1) of the Consumer Protection Act 1999, offenders may be fined up to RM10,000, jailed for up to two years, or both.



**AT THE COURTS**

The court heard that on Oct 28, 2025, the Tribunal President had ordered Sanny Automobile, the respondent, to refund RM8,000 to the claimant within 14 days of the award. However, the respondent failed to comply.

Following the non-compliance, the claimant lodged a report with the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living on Nov 18, 2025, prompting an investigation and subsequent prosecution.

Gunasegaran Krishan prosecuted.

In a separate case, a 37-year-old man was charged with breaching a police supervision order by failing to remain at his registered residence during

restricted hours.

Edwin Eking pleaded not guilty to being absent from his registered address at a house in Taman Che Mei Lido between 8pm and 6am, despite being subject to a police supervision order under Section 15 of the Prevention of Crime Act 1959.

The alleged offence occurred at about 12.30am on June 14.

The charge, under Section 15 of the Prevention of Crime Act 1959 read together with Section 15(4), carries a jail term of between two and five years upon conviction.

The court set Aug 12 for pre-trial case management and allowed bail of RM10,000 with two sureties. The accused was also ordered to report to a police station once a month as an additional bail condition.

Inspector Yusdi Basri prosecuted.

# KARYAWAN CALLS ON GOVT

## to take over music royalty collection, distribution system

**T**HE Malaysian Artists Association (Karyawan) has called on the government to take over the management of Malaysia's music royalty collection and distribution system to address issues that have plagued the industry for more than two decades.

Karyawan president Datuk Freddie Fernandez said in a statement on Monday that the proposal was among several resolutions unanimously adopted at the association's annual general meeting.

The proposal is modelled after Indonesia's system, where the National Collective Management Institution oversees the centralised collection of public performance royalties.

"Indonesia faced similar challenges until the government stepped in and assumed responsibility for royalty collection from the existing collecting bodies," he said.

Freddie said that with public performance royalty collections approaching RM200 million a year, it is time for Malaysia to reform its royalty collection and distribution system to ensure it is fairer, more transparent and accountable.

He said the local music industry has long faced complaints over a lack of transparency in royalty management, as well as the high administrative costs, fragmented collection structure, and disputes among collective management organisations and industry stakeholders over royalty distribution.

Karyawan also proposed that the government develop a centralised digital royalty management platform under government supervision to handle music rights

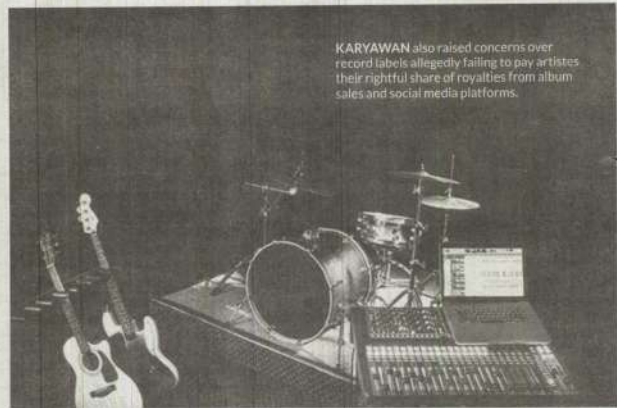
registration, usage tracking, royalty calculations and royalty distribution.

"The proposed platform would serve as the national music rights library and a government-managed royalty distribution system, where every musical work, sound recording, ownership structure, licensing record, usage report, royalty collection and distribution payment is recorded and verified, and auditable," he said.

Freddie said the system would ensure every use of a song is matched to its legitimate rights holder, allowing royalties to be calculated and distributed automatically based on verified ownership data and actual usage.

He added that the approach would reduce duplication in administrative processes, improve transparency and provide a clear audit trail for the government, rights holders, users and other stakeholders.

"It would also, to a certain extent, help regulate the use of AI-generated music — something that is likely to happen if no action is taken," he said.



KARYAWAN also raised concerns over record labels allegedly failing to pay artists their rightful share of royalties from album sales and social media platforms.

Freddie said the government-supervised model is consistent with the Copyright (Collective Management Organisation) Guidelines 2025 as it would strengthen governance, transparency, record-keeping, reporting and accountability in royalty management.

He said the proposal follows recent developments involving Karyawan, the Intellectual Property Corporation of Malaysia (MyIPO), the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living and the three royalty collection bodies — Music Authors' Copyright Protection, Public Performance Malaysia and Recording Performers Malaysia — which have taken legal action against the government.

Karyawan also raised concerns over record labels allegedly failing to pay artists their rightful share of royalties from album sales and social media platforms.

"This is evident from the case of the late Malaysian music legend Sudirman Arshad, whose family only recently received RM367,000 in royalties accumulated over several decades after waiting for many years.

"Since then, many of our members have come forward to say they have not received fair royalties from record sales and streaming services. Karyawan is currently gathering the necessary information to represent them in seeking justice and a fair resolution to their claims," he said. — BERNAMA

## RM10,000 poorer for selling diesel illegally

KOTA KINABALU: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Sabah branch secured another conviction against an individual found selling diesel without a valid licence under its Integrated Ops Tiris 4.0 operation.

Its Director Shahril Nizam Shahidin said Abdul Salam Ismail, 36, was fined RM10,000 or six months' jail if he failed to pay the fine after he pleaded guilty before Sessions Court Judge Hurman Hussain on June 25, 2026.

He said the accused who was charged under Regulation 3(1) of the Control of Supplies Regulations 1974, read together with Section 21 of the Control of Supplies Act 1961 (Act 122), subsequently settled the fine.

"The court also ordered that proceeds from the sale of the controlled item, namely diesel, amounting to RM774.09, be forfeited to the Government of Malaysia, while all seized items were ordered forfeited to the Government, except for the vehicle, which was ordered to be returned to its registered owner.

"For this offence, Section 22(1) of the Control of Supplies Act 1961 (Act 122) provides for a fine of up to RM1 million, imprisonment of up to three years, or both, for a first offence," Shahril said.

He said the prosecution was conducted by Deputy Public Prosecutor Malai Rosidi Malai Muhamad, while the accused was unrepresented by counsel.

"The offence was uncovered on April 19, 2026, following an intelligence-led operation by the Sabah Region 4 Marine Police

Force at a parking area along Jalan Tugu here.

"Upon inspection, the enforcement officers discovered 186 litres of diesel stored in a 1,000-litre intermediate bulk container (IBC) tank placed at the rear of a Toyota Hilux Rocco.

"Further investigations found that Abdul Salam did not possess a valid licence to trade in the scheduled controlled item which led to his arrest," he said.

In light of this, Shahril said KPDN Sabah would continue to intensify enforcement operations under Integrated Ops Tiris 4.0 through strategic cooperation with relevant enforcement agencies to curb the misappropriation of controlled goods and ensure government subsidies reach those genuinely entitled to receive them.

He said that KPDN would not compromise with any individual or party attempting to abuse controlled goods for personal gain, as such activities undermine public interest and result in losses to national revenue.

"It should also be noted that, apart from fines and imprisonment, the courts may order the forfeiture of seized items, including vehicles, as a firm measure to curb such illegal activities.

"We, therefore, urge the public to continue serving as the ministry's eyes and ears by channelling information on the misappropriation of controlled goods through KPDN's official reporting channels at KPDN Complaint WhatsApp: 019-848 8000 KPDN, KPDN e-Aduan Portal: <http://eaduan.kpdn.gov.my>, Call Centre: 1-800-886-800, and Ez ADU KPDN mobile application," he said.

## **Police bust counterfeit liquor syndicate, two men arrested**

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The police have taken down a syndicate involved in storing and distributing counterfeit liquor with the arrest of two men and the seizure of items worth RM1.65 million in the Klang Valley on Thursday (25 Jun).

An officer from the Bukit Aman Internal Security and Public Order Department's Wildlife Crimes Bureau/Integrated Special Investigations Team, SAC Datuk Mohd Zaki Ashar said the two men were arrested separately in Kepong and Bandar Utama, Petaling Jaya.

"A raid led to the arrest of a local man and a Sri Lankan man, in their 20s to 30s, who acted as the coordinator, store caretaker and deliveryman for the syndicate.

"Preliminary investigations show that the local man received RM3,000 a month to coordinate supply orders from a syndicate chief, while the foreigner received RM2,500 for deliveries to buyers," he said in a statement on Tuesday, adding that 11,496 tins and 9,737 bottles of liquor of various brands suspected to be counterfeit with unpaid Customs taxes were also seized.

Police also confiscated four commercial vehicles – three lorries and a van – used by the syndicate for distribution purposes.

The suspects and seized goods have been handed over to the Putrajaya Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry for investigation and further action under Section 102 of the Trademarks Act 2019, he added.

# Jafry: Sabah mohon pertimbangan khas subsidi diesel bersasar

## *Bagi industri pelancongan*

**KOTA KINABALU:** Kerajaan Persekutuan disaran mempertimbangkan mekanisme khas bagi pelaksanaan subsidi diesel bersasar untuk industri pelancongan di Sabah yang bergantung sepenuhnya kepada bahan api itu bagi meneruskan operasi harian.

Menteri Pelancongan, Kebudayaan dan Alam Sekitar Sabah, Datuk Jafry Ariffin, berkata pelaksanaan subsidi diesel bersasar perlu mengambil kira keunikan geografi serta realiti operasi di negeri ini yang jauh berbeza berbanding Semenanjung Malaysia.

Beliau berkata, had penggunaan diesel sebanyak 200 liter sebulan ketika ini tidak mencukupi untuk memenuhi keperluan pengusaha resort di pulau-pulau, pengendali bot pelancongan, operator aktiviti marin serta masyarakat di kawasan pedalaman yang menggunakan diesel sebagai sumber tenaga utama.

"Keadaan geografi Sabah yang mempunyai banyak kawasan pulau dan pedalaman menyebabkan diesel bukan lagi satu pilihan, sebaliknya menjadi keperluan asas bagi menjana bekalan elektrik, menggerakkan pengangkutan laut, logistik serta menyokong keseluruhan operasi harian.

"Justeru, Sabah wajar diberikan pertimbangan khas selaras dengan keunikan keadaan negeri ini," katanya dalam kenyataan media.

Jafry berkata, kementeriannya menerima pelbagai aduan dan maklum

balas daripada pemain industri pelancongan yang memaklumkan sebahagian besar daripada mereka tidak layak menerima subsidi di bawah Sistem Kawalan Diesel Bersubsidi (SKDS).

Katanya, keadaan itu menyebabkan mereka terpaksa menanggung kos operasi yang jauh lebih tinggi tanpa sebarang bentuk bantuan, sekali gus memberi tekanan kepada kelangsungan perniagaan.

Menurutnya, cabaran itu berlaku ketika industri pelancongan Sabah masih belum memasuki musim kemuncak ketibaan pelancong, menyebabkan peningkatan kos operasi terus menjejaskan margin keuntungan dan aliran tunai pengusaha.

"Ramai pengusaha kini berdepan cabaran untuk menampung kos utiliti, penyelenggaraan, logistik serta mengekalkan tenaga kerja.

"Sekiranya keadaan ini berterusan tanpa sokongan yang bersesuaian, ia boleh menjejaskan kelangsungan perniagaan pengusaha pelancongan di Sabah," katanya.

Sehubungan itu, beliau menyeru Kerajaan Persekutuan mempertimbangkan penyertaan sektor pelancongan dalam mekanisme subsidi diesel bersasar atau menyediakan kaedah khas yang lebih sesuai kepada pengusaha pelancongan yang beroperasi di pulau-pulau dan kawasan pedalaman.

Bagi memastikan perkara itu mendapat perhatian sewajarnya, be-

liau berkata, surat rasmi sudah dihantar kepada Menteri Pelancongan, Seni dan Budaya, Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing; Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup, Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali; serta Timbalan Menteri Ekonomi, Datuk Indera Mohd Shahar Abdullah bagi menyuarakan kebimbangan serta rayuan industri pelancongan Sabah.

Jafry berkata, industri pelancongan adalah antara penyumbang utama kepada ekonomi Sabah dan menyediakan peluang pekerjaan kepada ribuan rakyat negeri ini.

"Justeru, sebarang dasar berkaitan subsidi diesel perlu mengambil kira realiti operasi industri di Sabah supaya pengusaha pelancongan tidak terus dibebani kos yang tinggi sehingga menjejaskan kelangsungan perniagaan, sekali gus memastikan sektor pelancongan negeri terus berkembang secara mampan," katanya.

**KOTA KINABALU:** Kerajaan Persekutuan disaran mempertimbangkan mekanisme khas bagi pelaksanaan subsidi diesel bersasar untuk industri pelancongan di Sabah yang bergantung sepenuhnya kepada bahan api itu bagi meneruskan operasi harian.

Menteri Pelancongan, Kebudayaan dan Alam Sekitar, Datuk Jafry Ariffin berkata, pelaksanaan subsidi diesel bersasar perlu mengambil kira keunikan geografi serta realiti operasi di negeri ini yang jauh berbeza berbanding Semenanjung Malaysia.

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"Keadaan geografi Sabah yang mempunyai banyak kawasan pulau dan pedalaman menyebabkan diesel bukan lagi satu pilihan, sebaliknya menjadi keperluan asas bagi menjana bekalan elektrik, menggerakkan pengangkutan laut, logistik serta menyokong keseluruhan operasi harian.

"Justeru, Sabah wajar diberikan pertimbangan khas selaras dengan keunikan keadaan negeri ini," katanya dalam kenyataan media, semalam.

Jafry berkata, kementerian menerima pelbagai aduan dan maklum balas daripada pemain industri pelancongan yang memaklumkan sebahagian besar daripada mereka tidak layak menerima subsidi di bawah Sistem Kawalan Diesel Bersubsidi (SKDS).

Katanya, keadaan itu menyebabkan mereka terpaksa menanggung kos operasi yang jauh lebih tinggi tanpa sebarang bentuk bantuan, sekali gus memberi tekanan kepada kelangsungan perniagaan. Menurutnya, cabaran itu berlaku ketika industri pelancongan Sabah masih belum memasuki musim kemuncak ketibaan pelancong, menyebabkan peningkatan kos operasi terus menjejaskan margin keuntungan dan aliran tunai pengusaha.

"Ramai pengusaha kini berdepan cabaran untuk menampung kos utiliti, penyelenggaraan, logistik serta mengekalkan tenaga kerja.

"Sekiranya keadaan ini

berterusan tanpa sokongan yang bersesuaian, ia boleh menjejaskan kelangsungan perniagaan pengusaha pelancongan di Sabah," katanya.

Sehubungan itu, beliau menyeru kerajaan Persekutuan mempertimbangkan penyertaan sektor pelancongan dalam mekanisme subsidi diesel bersasar atau menyediakan kaedah khas yang lebih sesuai kepada pengusaha pelancongan yang beroperasi di pulau-pulau dan kawasan pedalaman.

Jafry berkata, bagi memastikan perkara itu mendapat perhatian sewajarnya, surat rasmi sudah dihantar kepada Menteri Pelancongan, Seni dan Budaya, Datuk Seri Tiong King Sing; Menteri Perdagangan Dalam Negeri

dan Kos Sara Hidup, Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali; serta Timbalan Menteri Ekonomi, Datuk Indera Mohd Shahar Abdullah bagi menyuarakan kebimbangan serta rayuan industri pelancongan Sabah.

Menurutnya, industri pelancongan adalah antara penyumbang utama kepada ekonomi Sabah dan menyediakan peluang pekerjaan kepada ribuan rakyat negeri ini.

"Justeru, sebarang dasar berkaitan subsidi diesel perlu mengambil kira realiti operasi industri di Sabah supaya pengusaha pelancongan tidak terus dibebani kos yang tinggi sehingga menjejaskan kelangsungan perniagaan, sekali gus memastikan sektor pelancongan negeri terus berkembang secara mampan," jelasnya.
