Bills passed to ensure fair competition

KUALA LUMPUR: The Dewan Rakyat on Monday passed the Competition (Amendment) Bill 2026 (Bill 712) and the Competition Commission (Amendment) Bill 2026 (Bill 713), strengthening the enforcement powers of the Malaysia Competition Commission (MyCC) in combating anti-competitive practices while enhancing protection for consumers and the domestic market.

Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister Datuk Armizan Mohd Ali (pic) said the amendments mark an important step in enhancing MyCC's capacity to carry out enforcement and investigations against anti-competitive conduct that harms the

market.

He said the approvals of the two Bills represent one of the ministry's key legislative reform initiatives to ensure the country's competition ecosystem remains fair, transparent and sustainable.

It is also in line with the Government's commitment to safeguarding consumer interests, curbing market manipulation and helping address cost of living issues through the implementation of a healthier competition framework.

"The focus of the amendments under Bill 712 is to strengthen MyCC's enforcement and investigative powers so that action against anti-competitive practices can be carried out more effectively, effi-

ciently and comprehensively.

"This initiative not only enhances protection for the market and consumers but also ensures that healthy competition continues to serve as a catalyst for the nation's economic growth," he said.

Elaborating, Armizan said Bill 712 comprises 34 amendments, involving improvements to 29 existing sections and the introduction of five new sections to strengthen the current legal framework.

Among the key amendments is the refinement of the definition of "association" under Section 2 to prevent trade associations from being misused as a platform for cartel arrangements or activities that could manipulate the market.

At the same time,

the amendment requires trade associations to be more accountable in ensuring that all their activities comply with competition laws, enabling them to play their proper role in advancing industry development without undermining fair competition.

One of the five new provisions is Section 35A, which provides for criminal action against any enterprise that fails to cooperate with or refuses to provide information to MyCC for the purpose of conducting market reviews.

"This new provision is important to ensure that every market review obtains complete, accurate and transparent data, allowing policies and enforcement actions to be formulated based on comprehensive facts."

Bill 712 also introduces Section 38A, which empowers MyCC to file an appeal

with the High Court if decisions made under Sections 35, 39 and 40 are overturned by the Competition Appeal Tribunal, he said.

Armizan said to ensure effective implementation of the amendments under Bill 712, Bill 713 has also been amended to improve nine existing sections and introduce new sections.

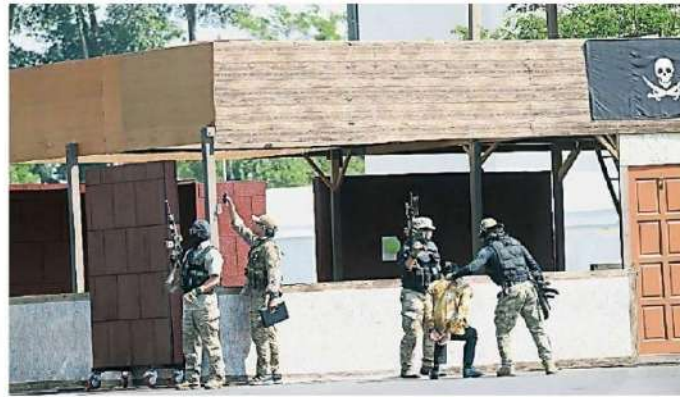
They clarify the powers of the Commis-

sion, including granting it delegated authority to carry out specific functions, thereby improving administrative efficiency and MyCC's enforcement capabilities.

The amendments to both Acts are expected to strengthen the integrity of the domestic market while boosting investor confidence in Malaysia's more transparent and competitive business ecosystem.

用未經認證秤具 2榴槤小販遭開罰

(实兆远7日讯)霹靂州国内贸易及生活费局执法人员，于日前在实兆远地区展开“榴槤商販執法行動”，当场对两名使用未經認證秤具營業的榴槤小販採取執法行動。

该局今日在脸书贴文指出，采取这项行动的目的，是要确保榴槤商販遵守2011年价格管制及反暴利法令及1972年秤具与测量法令。

执法人员在行动中检查了5个榴槤摊位，结果发现其中两名商販违反1972年秤具与测量法令第14(6)条文，即使用未經认证认证的秤具进行交易，因此遭开出罚单(罚款)。

执法人员在行动中，也对商販进行宣导工作，提醒商販遵守

法令及商业操守，包括需清楚标示不同等级或品种榴槤的售价，使用经马来西亚计量局检定认证的秤具，以及在消费局要求时，需开出收据。

该局强调将持续展开监督与执法检查，防止商家操纵价格

或重量，保障消费者的权益与福祉。

该局也呼吁公众，若发现任何可疑或不诚信的商业行为，可通过KPDN e-Aduan 投诉平台或Ez ADU手机应用程序提出正式举报。

PGA Kunak rekod RM2.9j rampasan sepanjang Jun

KUNAK: Batalion 22 Pasukan Gerakan Am (PGA) Kunak menahan 20 individu dalam 16 serbuan yang dijalankan sepanjang Jun lepas, dengan nilai keseluruhan rampasan pelbagai barangan berjumlah RM2,962,048.

Daripada jumlah tangkapan itu membabitkan 19 orang lelaki dan satu perempuan, merangkumi 12 individu warganegara dan lapan warga asing.

PGA Kunak dalam kenyataan berkata, kejayaan dan rampasan itu dijalankan hasil penugasan Cawangan Risik yang merangkumi operasi OP Tiris 4.0 dan OP Taring Esszone oleh Kompeni C pasukan Batalion 22.

"Keseluruhan rampasan melibatkan pelbagai jenis barangan seperti dadah, ayam sabung, rokok tanpa cukai, hasil-hasil hutan yang dicuri dan tanpa permit, hidupan liar (tenggiling), barangan kawalan termasuk tong gas silinder dan minyak petrol/ diesel serta kenderaan-kenderaan terlibat", kata kenyataan itu.

Dalam penugasan Op Tiris 4.0, seju-

lah enam kes melibatkan kesalahan dibawah Akta Kawalan Bekalan 1961 telah diserahkan kepada Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) cawangan Semporna untuk tindakan lanjut.

Kesalahan lain termasuk di bawah Akta Imigresen 1959/63, Enakmen Haiwan Sabah 2015, Akta Kastam 1967, Enakmen Pemeliharaan Hidupan Liar 1997 dan Enakmen Hutan Sabah 1968.

Pasukan itu juga menghargai kerjasama pelbagai agensi termasuk Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah Semporna, KPDN Semporna, Jabatan Perkhidmatan Veterinar Semporna dan Kunak, Kastam DiRaja Malaysia (Semporna), Jabatan Perhutanan Sabah, dan Jabatan Hidupan Liar Sabah yang terlibat dalam operasi penguatkuasaan.

"Batalion 22 PGA Kunak akan terus komited menguatkuasakan undang-undang yang sedia ada dan merakamkan ucapan terima kasih kepada masyarakat yang bersedia membantu dalam menyalurkan maklumat," katanya.

RM2.9mil seizures of goods by GOF Kunak

KUNAK: The 22nd Battalion of the General Operations Force (GOF) based here arrested 20 individuals in 16 raids conducted throughout June, with the total value of seized goods amounting to RM2,962,048.

Of those arrested, 19 were men and one was a woman.

The detainees comprised 12 Malaysians and eight foreign nationals.

In a statement, PGA Kunak said the arrests and seizures were the result of intelligence-led operations carried out by its Intelligence Branch under Op Tiris 4.0 and Op Taring Esszone, involving C Company of the 22nd Battalion.

The statement said the seizures included various items such as drugs, fighting cocks, untaxed cigarettes, illegally harvested and unpermitted forest products, protected wildlife (pangolins) and controlled goods including gas cylinders and petrol/diesel, as well as vehicles used in the offences.

Under Op Tiris 4.0, six cases involving offences under the Supply Control Act 1961 were handed over to the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN) Semporna Branch for further action. Other offences investigated involved violations under the Immigration Act 1959/63, Sabah Animal Enactment 2015, Customs Act 1967, Wildlife Conservation Enactment 1997 and Sabah Forest Enactment 1968.

The battalion also expressed appreciation for the cooperation of various enforcement agencies, including the Semporna District Police Headquarters, KPDN Semporna, the Veterinary Services Departments of Semporna and Kunak, the Royal Malaysian Customs Department (Semporna), the Sabah Forestry Department and the Sabah Wildlife Department, which participated in the enforcement operations.

"PGA Battalion 22 Kunak remains committed to enforcing existing laws and extends its appreciation to members of the public who continue to provide valuable information," the statement said.
