非法囤1120公斤煤氣 零售店遭霹內貿局取締

（太平14日讯）巴都古勞一家零售店逾量囤积一批14公斤的煤氣，遭霹雳州国内贸易及生活费局取締。

霹州内贸局局长拿督卡马鲁丁发文披露，太平执法队伍昨天联合多个执法机构展开“漏洞行动4.0”，揭发一家零售店储存80桶14公斤煤氣，总重量达1120公斤。

“执法人员随后根据1961年供应管制法令第8条文发出通知，要求业者提供有关统制品的拥有权资料。调查发现，该零售店虽持有合法零售执照，惟所储存的煤氣数量超出其执照所允许的储存限额。”

卡马鲁丁表示，执法队伍充公了这批煤氣桶，以及一些相关文件，

此次行动的充公数额约8528令吉。

“这起案件在1961年供应管制法令及1974年供应管制法令下展开调查。一旦罪成，初犯的个人可被判不超过100万令吉罚款、监禁不超过3年、或两者兼施；而机构、组织或公司，则最高可被罚款200万令吉。若属重犯，则可被判罚款不超过500万令吉。”

（太平14日讯）一家杂货店因存放超出统制品零售执照限额的液化石油气，结果遭太平国内贸易及生活成本局揭破，充公总值约8528令吉的80桶14公斤装液化石油气。

霹靂州国内贸易及生活成本局主任拿督卡马鲁丁指出，太平分局执法人员于昨早10时，在峇都古楼一间杂货店展开“滴漏联合取缔行动4.0”，发现店内存放统制品，即14公斤装液化石油气。

他发文说，执法人员随即援引1961年供应管制法令8条文发出通知书，要求业者提供店内统制品的持有资料。

“经业者回覆后，证实该店持有统制品零售执照，但现场共存放1120公斤液化石油气，超出其零售执照所允许持有的最高限额。”

他指出，该局援引1961年统制品法令及1974年统制品条例展开调查，罪成的个人可被判罚款不超过100万令吉，或监禁不超过3年，或两者兼施；至于公司或机构，一旦罪成，可被判罚款不超过200万令吉，重犯者最高可被判罚款500万令吉。

Sarawak to review foreign worker fee mechanism

KUCHING: The Sarawak government will study possible revisions to the fee mechanism under the Foreign Workers Transformation Approach (FWTA) to ease the financial burden on the business community.

Premier Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg gave the assurance during a courtesy call by the Associated Chinese Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Sarawak (ACCCIS), led by its president Kong Chiong Ung, at the Satria Pertiwi Complex here yesterday.

In a statement, ACCCIS said it had raised concerns with the Premier over the high application fees imposed under the FWTA, particularly their impact on small and medium enterprises (SMEs).

While supporting efforts to digitalise foreign worker management and improve administrative efficiency, the chamber urged the relevant authorities to review the current fee structure to reduce the financial strain on businesses.

The chamber also highlighted concerns over illegal online gambling and drug abuse, which it said not only affects public

safety and family well-being but also have adverse impacts on workforce productivity and youth development.

"ACCCIS proposed that the government continue to strengthen enforcement efforts, enhance public awareness and preventive education, while fostering greater collaboration among the government, business community and society as a whole to address these challenges and create a safer and healthier social environment," it said.

On the Subsidised Diesel Control Scheme (SKDS), ACCCIS said the existing subsidy quota did not adequately reflect Sarawak's vast geographical area, longer travel distances and challenging operating environment.

"The existing arrangement has placed significant cost pressures on sectors such as construction, agriculture, logistics and services. Many legitimate commercial vehicles remain excluded from the subsidy scheme, further increasing the operating burden faced by businesses," it said.

The chamber urged the Sarawak government to continue engaging with the federal

government to review the existing subsidy quota allocation and application mechanisms, and introduce a more flexible approach that better addresses Sarawak's needs.

"Such measures would help alleviate business costs while easing the financial pressure on the wider community," it added.

Abang Johari said the state government had conveyed Sarawak's concerns to the federal government and hoped further reviews and improvements would be made to the policies.

Meanwhile, the Premier agreed to allocate RM1.5 million to the Bintulu Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry for the establishment of the Bintulu Innovation and Enterprise Hub.

The initiative aims to support local businesses, encourage innovation and nurture entrepreneurs, especially among SMEs.

ACCCIS described the meeting as positive and constructive, reaffirming its commitment to serving as a bridge between the government and business community in supporting Sarawak's sustainable economic development.

Three Indonesians nabbed in multi-agency ops

KUCHING: Three Indonesians were arrested for alleged immigration offences after a multi-agency enforcement operation inspected several foreign-operated business premises here on Monday.

The operation, led by the Sarawak Immigration Department, was conducted between 8 am and 1 pm at Jalan Simpang Tiga, Jalan Pending and Jalan Haji Taha to ensure compliance with immigration and other related laws.

Enforcement teams conducted inspections on five premises under 'Ops Bersepadu' and 'Ops Selera', during which 32 individuals were screened.

Inspections led to the arrest of three Indonesians suspected of committing offences under Regulation 11(7)(a) of the Immigration Regulations 1963 and Section 15(1)(c) of the Immigration Act 1959/63.

Two witness summonses were also issued to assist with the

ongoing investigation.

A total of 39 enforcement officers from the Immigration Department, the Sarawak Ministry of Domestic Trade and Cost of Living (KPDN), and the Kuching Criminal Investigation Division (CID) took part in the operation.

Sarawak KPDN director Matthew Dominic Barin was also present during the operation, which also included advocacy sessions with business operators.

Besides immigration-related offences, KPDN officers detected several suspected violations under the Price Control and Anti-Profitteering Act 2011 and the Control of Supplies Act 1961.

The Sarawak Immigration Department said it would continue strengthening cooperation with other enforcement agencies to enhance compliance with the law and curb offences that could jeopardise public safety and national wellbeing.
